



Nominate a Public Servant for the 2011 Paul Simon Courage in Public Service Award

The sponsors of Lutheran Day 2011 are proud to open nominations for the 2011 Paul Simon Courage in Public Service Award. The award will be presented at Lutheran Day 2011, on May 11, in the Statehouse Rotunda in Springfield. The award honors the memory of the late Senator Paul Simon who served the people of Illinois with courage and with a dedication to public service for the common good.

CRITERIA

- The Simon Award recipient must have served in elected or appointed government office in Illinois in the current or the previous calendar year.
- The nominee may be considered for a particular act of courageous public service or for a career-long commitment to justice and compassion.
- The nominee's ability to interpret his or her public action from a personal faith basis will be a "bonus" consideration, but is not a prerequisite for the award.

Anyone may submit a nomination.

- To submit a nomination for the 2011 Paul Simon Courage in Public Policy Award, please submit by e-mail (preferred), fax, postal service or hand delivery a brief message including contact information for the person making the nomination, contact information for the nominee (if available), the nominee's current professional position, and the reason why this person should be considered for the Simon Award.
- Nominations must be received by the close of business on April 8, 2011.
